As per the letter No. SDTE-HTE-HTE-I-0018-2017/752/SDTE, Dated 13th February 2018, from the department of Skill Development and Technical Education(SDTE), Govt. of Odisha, the OJEE Committee has decided to increase the percentage of quota of seats for Persons with Disabilities from 3% to 5% in taking admissions into relevant Under Graduate (UG) and Post Graduate (PG) courses for the academic session 2018-19. Notification regarding the same shall be given during the process of counselling and admission in the month of June 2018 onwards after the declaration of OJEE results. During online registration for counselling, a candidate can fill up and claim his/her disability status. However, all the candidates shall be required to appear at a medical board at SCB Medical college to get their degree of disability verified. Detail information to all the candidates regarding the date and venue of the Medical board shall be notified in the OJEE website and leading newspapers before the counselling.
